



# MANLY WARRINGAH BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION AGREEMENT FORM

Dear Parents- *Please read this document carefully, as it contains important information*

Congratulations on your child's selection in the 2019 **MWBA** Junior Representative Program. The fee for 2019 is **\$565**, split into 2 installments - **\$265** to be paid immediately & then **\$300** which will be invoiced prior to the season starting. Attached is the first invoice.

The estimated cost for each player to play Representative Basketball is \$900+. This is mainly being court hire and BNSW fees beyond our control. MWBA relies on fundraising to keep costs down. **Fundraising is a part of sport & is compulsory.**

## Fees and **compulsory** fundraising contribution is as follows.

- **Representative fee \$565** – split into **2** installments - **\$265** due 6th Dec 2017 (confirms players team placement) & **\$300** due 1<sup>st</sup> March 2018
- **New fundraiser** which will be confirmed at the commencement of the MWBA Rep season. No more chocolates.
- **Trivia Night** – 2 tickets must be purchased by each family, **\$25** each, so **\$50** per family, must be paid up front, prior to the event, **even if you are unable to attend**. This is an expectation. Trivia Night is usually held around June, dates will be confirmed ASAP.
- Most venues charge a **\$4 entry fee**, this fee is set by BNSW, & contributes to game costs.
- **Rep Camps** will run during the school holiday periods, & players are strongly encouraged to attend.

## Other Compulsory Requirements. There are **certain requirements** for your child to play in the **MWBA Representative Program**.

- **All fees** must be **paid** prior to the commencement of the season
- Attend **all** training and/or skills sessions for their team and **all** competition games
- **Adhere** to the BNSW Codes of Conduct, Representative/Development Player Agreement, and the Zero Tolerance Policy for Parents and Spectators
- Parents must commit to **Scoretable** and **BBQ** duties. These will be organized by each Team Manager.
- **Other** Representative sports **WILL NOT CONFLICT** with **Rep Basketball** commitments, including both **games & training**. **Failure to comply with this, could result in the player concerned being withdrawn from the team**
- **Allow MWBA** to use your contact details for Fee invoicing, Newsletters, & also by Coaches & Managers for all team information & communication, including training, game times, venues & contact distribution lists.

**Basketball NSW - Codes of Conduct, Representative and Player agreements** and the **Zero Tolerance Policy** for Parents and Spectators - **must be read through thoroughly, before signing this document below** - They are displayed on the **Representative** page on our Website.
