Entries:

We have had a large number of enquiries regarding the competitions and expect some of the divisions to be oversubscribed. Avoid disappointment by getting your entries in on time. We are endeavoring to avoid 10 pm games wherever possible. Players will only be allowed to play in **ONE** senior team per night. Difficulties have arisen as court space is at a premium and also duties not being covered.

Entries for all competitions are done through Trybooking: https://www.trybooking.com/book/event?eid=451920& by Monday 28th January @ 9pm. A deposit of \$250 will be taken and deducted from your competition fees.

Referees:

In line with past practice, all teams are required to nominate two members who can act as referees during the team's rostered duty. Please note that providing referees is a requirement and all teams <u>MUST</u> have two (2) referees available at the court for rostered duties. Free tuition is available from the Association

COMPETITION FEES (Inc. GST)

REGISTRATION:

All players must be registered or affiliated with the M.W.B.A. Registration includes Basketball Australia Insurance.

Senior - \$115 for 12 months.
Non Registered players will NOT be permitted to take the court after 2 weeks of play. Any team that plays an unregistered player will lose the points for the game played.

AFFILIATION: This fee of \$50 is paid only by players who are registered at a basketball association other than the MWBA. *MWBA registered players do not pay this fee.*

COURT FEES: Court Fees \$915 Premier League division (10 weeks) and \$1500 for Div. 2 - 4 per team(19 weeks).

An invoice will be forwarded to the Manager.

- The Manager has 14 days to pay the full amount in full. Game points will be forfeited for any un-financial team.
- Due to the number of forfeits being experienced, teams are allowed one forfeit if notification to MWBA office is before 9am on game day. If a team forfeits more than once or after 9am on game day, a forfeit fee of \$50 will be charged for every forfeit made thereafter. Payment must be made before next scheduled game.
- MWBA reserves the right to refuse playing time to teams that have not paid court fees as above.

FAILURE TO DO DUTY: A\$35 fine will be charged if teams do not meet duty requirements.

WITHDRAWAL:

- Teams withdrawing from competitions after the draw has been produced will forfeit their deposit.
- Players from un-financial teams will be required to pay their portion of any moneys owed to MWBA by the team before they play for any other team.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Scoresheet: Player's numbers must be printed neatly on the Scoresheet before the game commences.

Injuries: Details of the nature and circumstances of any player injury must be recorded on an "Injury Report Form" available from the Court Supervisor or the Basketball Office.

Team Uniforms: All teams must have a proper set of identical uniform. Uniforms must be properly numbered (preferably 4-15, but 'NBA' numbers are acceptable) on the front and the back of all uniforms. Taped or hand written numbers are not acceptable. All members of a team must wear the same colored shorts (pockets are not permissible)

Referees: <u>RUDENESS</u> towards referees or constant questioning of calls will <u>NOT</u> be tolerated. Court Supervisors or Referees may cite constant offenders to appear before a disciplinary tribunal and these offenders may suffer lengthy suspensions.
